COURSE DESCRIPTION

Chorus, orchestra, & musical theatre classes at Mandarin Middle School are performance-based ensembles designed to give students the opportunity to develop and improve individual musical, vocal, and/or instrumental skills. Since these ensembles are performance-based, students are required to attend all activities including after school rehearsals and performances for their ensembles. This occurs at least ONE TIME per quarter with a planned morning required rehearsal the morning of the performance.
